Parking Arrangements

To ensure compliance with **Health & Safety** regulations regarding free access to emergency vehicles there must be no vehicles left outside the Handicraft marquee.

Exhibitors wishing to drop off exhibits by bringing their car onto the show field **MUST** purchase a car parking pass for £10 which will entitle them to a ringside parking space. If the vehicle is removed from the field by 10.30am the parking fee will be refunded.

Any vehicle parked outside the marquee after 10.30am will be towed away at the owner's risk.

The CAR PARKING PASS IS IN ADDITION TO AN EXHIBITORS TICKET (FOR ENTRIES £10 OR OVER)

Rules

- 1. Entries must be received by **Tuesday 1**st **August 2023** on the official entry form and THE FEE MUST BE ENCLOSED OR PAID ONLINE also please enclose a self-addressed envelope (approx. A5 size) with a large letter stamp. **No late entries will be accepted.**
- 2. ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE STAGED BY 10.00am and may not be removed BEFORE 4.00pm, both under the direction of the staging committee. The tent will be open to the public when judging has finished at approximately 12.30pm.
- 3. Judging will commence at 10.00am.
- 4. All work must be the work of the exhibitor.
- 5. TWO ENTRIES allowed per person per class.

- 8. Only two prizes to be awarded if less than four entries staged, but the judge has the power to award prizes at his or her discretion.
- 9. Classes with 20 or more entries the judge may award a 4th prize.
- 10. No exhibit is allowed which has previously been exhibited at Gosforth Show.
- 11. Every care will be taken to safeguard exhibitions, but the society undertakes no liability. Entries are accepted on this condition.
- 12. The society reserves the right to refuse any exhibits.

- 14. All exhibitors must pay the entrance fee at the gate.

Lakeland Lemon Cake Recipe

Ingredients

90.

225g / 8oz Self Raising flour pinch of ground cinnamon 175g / 6oz butter half level teaspoon ground ginger 175g / 6oz caster sugar 2 large eggs beaten pinch of salt grated rind and juice of 1 lemon 1 tablespoon milk

Set oven to 165c / 325f gas Mark 3
Grease and line the base and sides of a 18cm/ 7 inch round cake tin

MEN ONLY – 3 Shortbread biscuits

Method

- 1. Cream together the butter and sugar till pale and fluffy.
- 2. Add the beaten eggs, salt, cinnamon, ginger.
- 3. Sieve in the flour and mix well.
- 4. Add the lemon rind and juice and then add the milk.
- 5. Mix well and place in the prepared tin. Level the top.
- 6. Bake for about 1 hour until firm and pale brown.
- 7. Leave in the tin for 15 mins then transfer to a wire rack.
- 8. Keep for 48 hours before cutting.
