Please ensure that your birds arrive in good health and in a box with clean shavings. Entries cannot be accepted from anyone in any current Avian Influenza Prevention Zone.

Feeding and watering of all birds must be carried out by each exhibitor after judging is completed. Exhibitors need to provide their own supplies, including water and water dishes.

The Show and Venue are not responsible for the loss, damage or illness of any birds; and all bills will be paid for by the owner of the bird.
