#### **Parking Arrangements**

To ensure compliance with **Health & Safety** regulations regarding free access to emergency vehicles there must be no vehicles left outside the Handicraft marquee.

Exhibitors wishing to drop off exhibits by bringing their car onto the show field **MUST** purchase a car parking pass for **£10** which will entitle them to a ringside parking space. If the vehicle is removed from the field by 10.30am the parking fee will be refunded.

Any vehicle parked outside the marquee after 10.30am will be towed away at the owner's risk.

## Rules

1. Entries must be received by **Friday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025** on the official entry form and **THE FEE MUST BE ENCLOSED OR PAID ONLINE** also please enclose a self-addressed envelope (approx. A5 size) with a large letter stamp. **No late entries will be accepted.**
2. ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE STAGED BY 10.00am and may not be removed BEFORE 4.00pm, both under the direction of the staging committee. The tent will be open to the public when judging has finished at approximately 12.30pm.
3. Judging will commence at 10.00am.
4. All work must be the work of the exhibitor.
5. TWO ENTRIES allowed per person per class.
6. **A self-addressed envelope (approx. A5 size) with a large letter stamp must be enclosed with your entry form to receive your exhibitor's tickets. No tickets issued on the day**
7. All exhibits of eggs to be shown on plates provided by the society without doilies, mats or other decorations of any description.
8. Only two prizes to be awarded if less than four entries staged, but the judge has the power to award prizes at his or her discretion.
9. Classes with 20 or more entries the judge may award a 4<sup>th</sup> prize.
10. No exhibit is allowed which has previously been exhibited at Gosforth Show.
11. Every care will be taken to safeguard exhibits, but the society undertakes no liability. Entries are accepted on this condition.
12. The society reserves the right to refuse any exhibits.
13. No soiled or worn articles will be accepted.
14. **All exhibitors must pay the entrance fee at the gate.**
15. Exhibitors with entry fees of £10 are given one free entrance ticket to the Show but still need to buy a Car Parking Ticket.
16. No responsibility will be taken for any entry not picked up by exhibitor by 5.00pm.
17. Prize money not collected by 5.00pm will be forfeited.
18. In accordance with **GDPR** (General Data Protection Regulations) we therefore ask you to 'Opt In' when completing the entering to enable us to provide this service and future Gosforth Agricultural Society information to you. Please be assured that your information will not be offered to any third party and will be for the sole use as described here. By opting in, exhibitors accept that data will be published in our Show Catalogue, and results will be published on the Society's website, Facebook page and given to the local press.

# **Egremont Cake Recipe**

## **Ingredients**

9oz/255g SR Flour  
1oz/28g cocoa powder  
7oz/198g caster sugar  
1 large egg  
1oz/28g golden syrup  
4oz/113g margarine  
6oz tepid milk  
Pinch salt  
Half a level teaspoon bicarbonate of soda mixed with 3oz hot water

## **Icing**

250g Icing sugar  
2 tablespoons cocoa powder  
Add water to mix

Set oven at 180c gas mark 4

## **Method**

Grease and line an 8 inch/20 cm square tin.  
Sieve flour, cocoa and salt into a bowl.  
Add sugar, warm the syrup and margarine until melted.  
Add to flour and mix well.  
Add beaten egg and tepid milk and mix well.  
Then add the bicarbonate of soda mixture and blend in.  
Pour into the prepared tin.  
Bake for 30-40 minutes until firm.  
Leave in the tin for 15minutes, then turn out onto a wire rack.  
When cold spread with chocolate icing.
